Here are a few examples of "fun" company picnic locations and events:

Many companies report rarely seeing their co-workers throughout the day. Long lines and extra fees for parking can dampen the spirits of your guests. Additionally, while children enjoy the day, most adults sit on the sideline and don't participate in the festivities because they are not willing to parade around their fellow employees in a bathing suit. (Honestly, I can't blame them.)

Outdoor Park - Free or private parks can provide a beautiful setting for a get together but often lack the entertainment value of other options. While some older adults may enjoy spending the day sitting at a picnic table, many of your guests (young and old alike) will be looking for activities and attractions that provide a little more excitement.
